



## WHY YOU SHOULD RECORD YOUR COLOR PALETTE:

Painting the exterior of your home can be overwhelming. Documenting your paint colors along with the surfaces they were painted will save you a lot of time with future touch-ups.

Use this *Exterior Colour Palette* to document and record your new or existing exterior colour pallet. Copy or print (page 7 and 8) for multiple rooms or larger exteriors. Store and file away all documents together for your future records.

Start with filling in the project information above and then follow the instructions on the next page. It's best to print off a copy or simply input the data using your device and save it.

## **HOW TO USE YOUR EXTERIOR COLOR PALETTE:**

Use the legend below to help guide and understand the descriptions of each part of the color palette sheet. Print a physical copy (with the color dab on the page) as well as a digital copy for securing future records.

#### **1. Color Palette Name:**

Name the color pallet of your painting project. (It's fun being creative!)

#### 2. Date Painted:

Add the date(s) that your home was painted. This will help with the timeline for future touchups and records management.

#### 3. Surface:

With proper prep and application, almost anything can be painted. Use this space to identify the object or surface that was painted.

#### 4. Paint Brand:

Sometimes the same color name can be used by other paint manufacturers. Identify the Brand and the product name.

#### 5. Product Name:

The product name is usually the largest print on the label.





#### 6. Color Name:

Add the name of the color you chose in this section.

#### 7. Color Code:

Add the color code of the paint color in this section.

#### 8. Sheen / Gloss:

This section describes the shininess of the paint. Is the paint flat, eggshell, semigloss or high gloss? Check the paint can to view the sheen level,

#### 9. Color Dab:

Use a rag, small brush or fingertip and apply a small paint sample of each paint color used to this section. Allow the paint to dry before storing or folding.


